

## Shell ridge stitch

Crochet textured pattern with post stitches #0021



## UK term | US term

Chain Stitch - ch

Double crochet / Single crochet – dc/sc

Front Post dc/sc - FPdc/sc

Treble / Double crochet – tr/dc

Front Post tr/dc – FPtr/dc

Back Post tr/dc – BPtr/dc

Half tr/dc – htr/hdc

Post stitch – Pst

**Foundation Chain:** Multiples of 12 + 2

**Row 1:** Skip 1h, \* 1dc/sc in each of next 4ch, skip 2ch, 5tr/dc in next ch, skip 2ch, 1dc/sc in each of next 3ch; rep from \*, 1dc/sc in last ch, turn.



Row 2: Make 1ch and 1dc/sc in first st,

\* 1dc/sc in each of next 2dc/sc below, [1BPtr/dc over tr/dc below, 1tr/dc in space between two tr/dc] – work 4 times, 1BPtr/dc over last tr/dc below, skip 1dc/sc, 1dc/sc in each of next 3dc/sc below; rep from \*, turn.



Row 3: Make 1ch and 1dc/sc in first st,

\* 1dc/sc in next st, [ 1 FPtr/dc over Pst below, 1tr/dc in space between Pst and tr/dc, 1tr/dc in next space between tr/dc and Pst] – work 4 times, 1 FPtr/dc over last Pst, skip 1dc/sc below, 1dc/sc in each of next 2st; rep from \*, turn.





Row 4: Make 1ch and 1dc/sc in first st,

\* make 13FPdc/sc over Pst and tr/dc below, skip 1dc/sc, 1dc/sc in next st; rep from \*, turn.



**Row 5:** Make 3ch and 3tr/dc in same space as first dc/sc of row 1,

\* skip 3Pst, 1dc/sc in each of next 7Pst below, make 5tr/dc in same space as middle dc/sc of row 1; rep from\*,

skip 3Pst, 1dc/sc in each of next 7Pst below, make 3tr/dc in same space as last dc/sc of row 1, 1htr/hdc in last dc/sc below, turn.







**Row 6:** Make 3ch and skip first st, [1tr/dc in space between two tr/dc, 1BPtr/dc over next tr/dc below] – work 2 times,

\* skip 1dc/sc, 1dc/sc in each of next 5dc/sc below, [1BPtr/dc over tr/dc below, 1tr/dc in space between two tr/dc] – work 4 times, 1 BPtr/dc over last tr/dc below; rep from \*,

skip 1dc/sc, 1dc/sc in each of next 5dc/sc below, [1BPtr/dc over tr/dc below, 1tr/dc in space between two tr/dc] – work 2 times, 1tr/dc in third ch, turn.



Row 7: Make 3ch and skip first st, [1tr/dc in space between sts, 1tr/dc in next space between sts, 1 FPtr/dc over Pst below] – work 2 times,

\* skip 1dc/sc, 1dc/sc in each of next 3dc/sc below, [ 1FPtr/dc over Pst below, 1tr/dc in



space between Pst and tr/dc, 1tr/dc in next space between tr/dc and Pst] – work 4 times, 1 FPtr/dc over last Pst; rep from \*,

skip 1dc/sc, 1dc/sc in each of next 3dc/sc below, [ 1FPtr/dc over Pst below, 1tr/dc in space between Pst and tr/dc, 1tr/dc in next space between tr/dc and Pst] – work 2 times, 1tr/dc in third ch, turn.



Row 8: Make 1ch and 1dc/sc in first st, make 6FPdc/sc over Pst and tr/dc below,

\* skip 1dc/sc, 1dc/sc in next st, 13FPdc/sc over Pst and tr/dc below; rep from \*,

skip 1dc/sc, 1dc/sc in next st, 6FPdc/sc over Pst, 1dc/sc in third ch, turn.



Row 9: Make 1ch and 1dc/sc in first st,

\* 1dc/sc in each of next 3st, make 5tr/dc in same space as middle dc/sc of row 5, skip 3Pst, 1dc/sc in each of next 4Pst below; rep from\*, 1dc/sc in last ch, turn.





*Repeat rows* 2 - 9 until you have reached your desired length.

## **Materials**

Fingering weight yarn, and crochet hook size 2.5 - 2.75 mm / C.

You may use any yarn of your choice, and a suitable hook.









## Colors and rows

\* 1, 2, 3 & 4 – pink; 5, 6, 7 & 8 – blue; 9, 10, 11 & 12 – beige; 13, 14, 15 & 16 – white \*.
