

Shell fan stitch

Crochet stitch pattern featuring textured fan shells #0084



UK term | US term

Chain Stitch - ch

Slip stitch - slt

Double crochet / single crochet – dc/sc

Double treble / triple – dtr/tr

Foundation Chain: Multiples of 19 + 2

Row 1: skip 1ch and work 1dc/sc in next,

* [2ch, skip 2ch, slt in next] – make 2 times, 1ch, skip 1ch, slt in next, 2ch, skip 2ch, slt in next, 1ch, skip 1ch, slt in next, [2ch, skip 2ch, slt in next] – make 2 times; rep from *,


work 1dc/sc in last ch instead of making slt, turn.




Row 2 (RS): make 2ch,

* work 1dc/sc in next space of 2ch, skip one space of 2ch and one space of 1ch, work shell into next space of 2ch:

Make 7ch and slt in space of 2ch, turn.



Make 3ch, skip 3ch and work 1dc/sc in each of next 4ch, turn.








[Make 2ch, work 1dc/sc in back loop of each of next 4dc/sc below, 3ch, make slt in same space of 2ch, turn.





Work 3 ch, 1dc/sc in back loop of each of next 4dc/sc below.





Turn.] – repeat 6 more times until you have 15 rows of textured dc/sc.

Continue the row: skip one space of 1ch and one space of 2ch, work 1dc/sc in next space of 2ch, 1ch; rep from *,





work 1dc/sc in last dc/sc instead of making 1ch, turn.





Row 3: make 5ch and 1dtr/tr in first dc/sc,

* 1ch, skip 3 rows (of textured dc/sc) of next shell and work slt in back loop of dc/sc of next row, [2ch, skip 1row, work slt in back loop of dc/sc of next row] – repeat 3 more times until you have 4 spaces of 2ch, 1ch,





make 1dtr/tr + 1ch + 1dtr/tr in space of 1ch below; rep from *,



work 2dtr/tr in last space of 2ch instead of making 1dtr/tr + 1ch + 1dtr/tr, turn.



Row 4:

First shell

Make 9ch, skip 2ch and work 1dc/sc in each of next 4ch, 3ch, make slt in space between two dtr/tr, turn.






Work 3 ch and 1dc/sc in back loop of each of next 4dc/sc, turn.

[Make 2ch, work 1dc/sc in back loop of each of next 4dc/sc below, 3ch, make slt in same space between two dtr/tr, turn.

Work 3 ch, 1dc/sc in back loop of each of next 4dc/sc below, turn.] – repeat 2 more times until you have 8 rows of textured dc/sc.



Continue the row: * skip one space of 2ch and work 1dc/sc in next space of 2ch, 1ch, 1dc/sc in next space of 2ch, make shell in space of 1ch between two dtr/tr below; rep from *.





Skip one space of 2ch and work 1dc/sc in next space, 1ch, 1dc/sc in next space, make last shell.

Last shell

Make 7ch and slt in space between dtr/tr and 5ch, turn.

Make 3ch, skip 3ch and work 1dc/sc in each of next 4ch, turn.






[Make 2ch, work 1dc/sc in back loop of each of next 4dc/sc below, 3ch, make slt in same space between dtr/tr and 5ch, turn.

Work 3ch, 1dc/sc in back loop of each of next 4dc/sc below, turn.] – repeat 3 more times until you have 9 rows of textured dc/sc, turn.



Row 5: make 1ch and 1dc/sc in back loop of dc/sc of next row of shell, [2ch, skip 1row, work slt in back loop of dc/sc of next row] – repeat 1 more time,



* 1ch, make 1dtr/tr + 1ch + 1dtr/tr in space of 1ch below, 1ch,





skip 3 rows of next shell and work slt in back loop of dc/sc of next row, [2ch, skip 1row, work slt in back loop of dc/sc of next row] – repeat 3 more times until you have 4 spaces of 2ch; rep from *.

Work 1ch, make 1dtr/tr + 1ch + 1dtr/tr in space of 1ch below, 1ch, skip 3 rows of next shell and work slt in back loop of dc/sc of next row,

2ch, skip 1row, work slt in back loop of dc/sc of next row, 2ch, make 1dc/sc in space of 2ch on top of shell, turn.





Row 6: make 2ch,

* work 1dc/sc in next space of 2ch, work shell into space of 1ch between two dtr/tr, skip one space of 2ch, work 1dc/sc in next space of 2ch, 1ch; rep from *,

work 1dc/sc in last dc/sc instead of making 1ch, turn.



Repeat rows 3 - 6 until you have reached your desired length.

Materials

Fingering weight yarn, and crochet hook size 2.5 - 2.75 mm / C.

You may use any yarn of your choice, and a suitable hook.
