

Openwork bobble stitch

Crochet openwork stitch featuring bobbles

UK term | US term

Chain stitch – ch

Double crochet / Single crochet – dc/sc

Treble / Double crochet – tr / dc

Stitch – st

Cluster of 7 tr/dc – cls: make 7 incomplete tr/dc.



Yarn over and draw through all loops on hook.



Foundation Chain: Multiples of 6

Row 1: Skip 1 ch,

* 1 dc/sc in next ch, 5ch, skip 3ch, 1 dc/sc in next, 3ch, skip 1ch; rep from *,

1 dc/sc in next ch, 5ch, 1 dc/sc in last ch, turn.



Row 2: Make 5ch,

* 1 dc/sc in space of 5ch, 2ch, 1 cls in space of 3ch, 2ch; rep from *,

1 dc/sc in space of 5ch, 2ch, 1 tr/dc in last dc/sc below, turn.



Row 3: Make 1ch and 1 dc/sc in tr/dc below,

* 3ch, 1 dc/sc in next space of 2ch, 5ch, 1 dc/sc in next space of 2ch; rep from *,

3ch, 1dc/sc in third ch, turn.



Row 4: Make 5ch,

* 1cls in space of 3ch, 2ch, 1dc/sc in space of 5ch, 2ch; rep from *,

1cls in space of 3ch, 2ch, 1tr/dc in last dc/sc below, turn.



Row 5: Make 1ch and 1dc/sc in tr/dc below,

* 5ch, 1dc/sc in next space of 2ch, 3ch, 1dc/sc in next space of 2ch; rep from *,

5ch, 1dc/sc in third ch, turn.



Repeat rows 2 – 5 until you have reached your desired length.

Materials

Fingering weight yarn, and crochet hook size 2.5 - 2.75 mm / C.

You may use any yarn of your choice, and a suitable hook.



Colors & rows

1, 2, 3, 4, 5 & 6 – grey; 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 & 12 – light blue; 13, 14, 15, 16, 17 & 18 – blue; 19, 20, 21, 22, 23 & 24 – light yellow; 25, 26, 27, 28, 29 & 30 – yellow.
