

Textured picot stitch

Crochet pattern with picot and post stitches

UK term | US term

Chain = ch

Double crochet / single crochet = dc / sc

Half treble / half double crochet = htr / hdc

Front post treble / front post double crochet
= FPtr / FPdc

Post stitch = Pst

Foundation Chain: Multiple of 2 ch

Row 1: Sk 1 ch, dc/sc in next ch, * dc/sc in next ch, ch 4, dc/sc in 4th ch from hook, sk 1 ch; rep from * across to last 2 ch, dc/sc in each of last 2 ch, turn.



Row 2: Ch 2, sk first st, * FPtr/FPdc around post of next st, ch 1; rep from * across to last st, FPtr/FPdc around post of next st, htr/hdc in last st, turn.



Row 3: Ch 1, dc/sc in htr/hdc, * dc/sc in next Pst, ch 4, dc/sc in 4th ch from hook; rep from * across to last Pst, dc/sc in Pst, dc/sc in top of turning ch, turn.



Repeat rows 2 - 3 until you have reached your desired length.

Materials

1 - Fingering weight yarn, and crochet hook size 2.5 - 2.75 mm (C/2 US).

2 - DK weight yarn, and crochet hook size 3.5mm (E/4 US) or 4mm (G/6 US) or size appropriate for your yarn choice

Note: Pattern can be worked with any yarn weight; simply adjust hook size accordingly.

Colors & Rows

* 1 - white; 2 & 3 - light pink; 4 & 5 - white; 6 & 7 - pink; 8, 9, 10, 11, 12 & 13 - white; 14 & 15 - light green; 16 & 17 - white; 18 & 19 - green; 20, 21, 22, 23 & 24 - white *.
